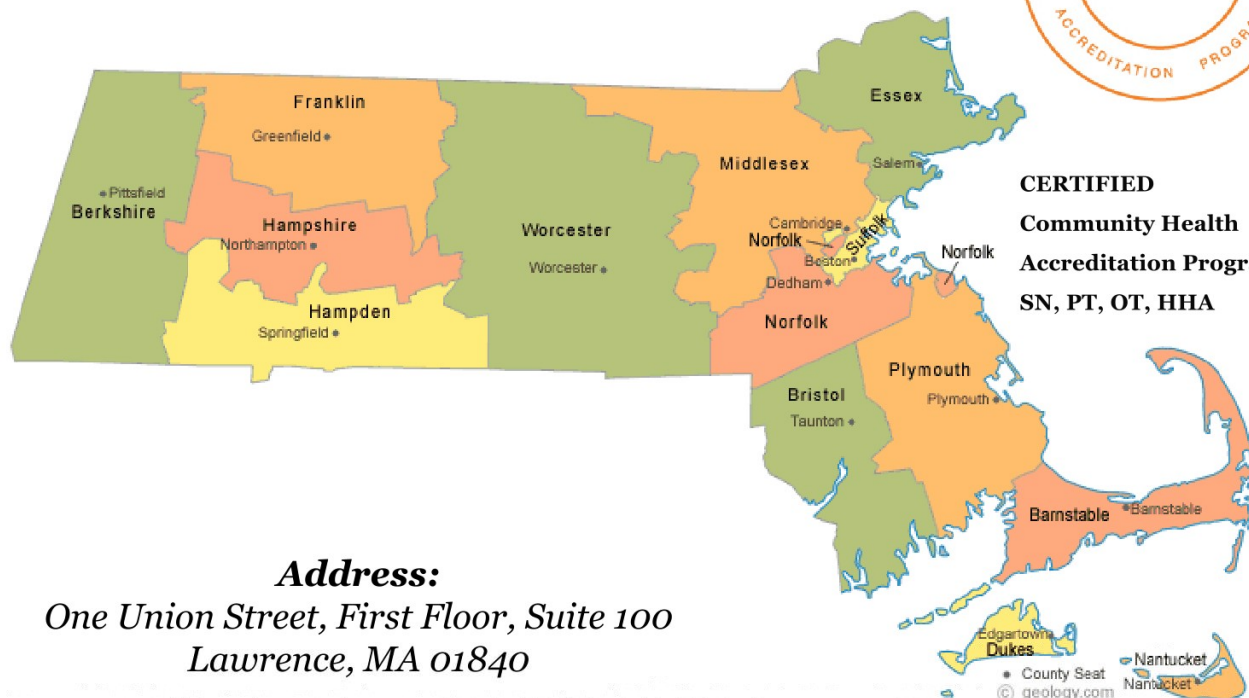

OUR GOAL

BHHA offers a unique voluntary mental health/ medical treatment plan which utilizes the collaboration of all disciplines (RN, PT, OT, and HHA) to individualize each plan of care.

Our Goal is to promote independent living in the community and prevent re-hospitalizations through Care Plan Development, Medication Management, Crisis Intervention, Coordination of Care, Coordination of Community Resources and ongoing communication with providers and disciplines

The Behavioral Health Services includes the following:

- Assessment and individual treatment planning
- Plan of care based on reality of client's life and home situation, addressing their health status, knowledge and selfcare skills
- Medication monitoring, including administration of Deconate medications to include Haldol and Prolixin, as well as the following injections: Risperdal Consta, Invega Sustena, Vivitrol, and Abilify Maintena.
- Behavioral management
- Crisis intervention
- Telephone support
- ANCC Certified Psychiatric nurses to manage the care of the client

Through interdisciplinary teamwork the following may occur:

- The nurse may make initial contact with the client in the hospital
- The nurse participates in the discharge planning meetings
- The nurse collaborates with all disciplines involved by communicating through regular telephone contact to the MD, case managers and other mental health professionals involved in the care of the client

Patients who Benefit from Behavioral Health Intervention Include:

- A History of Medication/Plan of Care Non-Adherence
- Need of Behavioral management/substance Abuse/DrugCourt/Probation
- Fail To "Connect" with traditional outpatient services
- Limited Social Support
- Dual Diagnosis-Psychosis/Behavioral and Poly Substance
- Develop mental Disabilities
- Impaired Functional Ability
- Significant family issues
- Diagnosis of HIV/AIDS
- Experiencing issues of Loss/ Grieving
- Experiencing Anxiety, Pain, Depression and isolative behaviors
- Diagnosis of Dementia, Alzheimer's, and/or other Cognitive Impairment
